**The Planning (Control of Advertisements)
(Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2009**

Advertisements on sites used for preceding ten years for display of advertisements without express consent

7. In Part 1 of Schedule 3 after CLASS 11 insert—

<i>“CLASS 12</i>	<i>Advertisements on sites used for preceding ten years for display of advertisements without express consent</i>
Description	An advertisement displayed on a site that has been used continually for the preceding ten years for the display of advertisements without express consent.
Conditions	<p>(a) The advertisement does not fall within this description if, during the relevant 10-year period, there has been either a material increase in the extent to which the site has been used for the display of advertisements or a material alteration in the manner in which it has been so used.</p> <p>(b) If any building on which such an advertisement is displayed—</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(i) is removed in compliance with a requirement of, or under, any statutory provision;(ii) is removed in any other circumstances; or(iii) is destroyed by any means; <p>the erection of any building to continue the display is not permitted.</p> <p>(c) Illumination is not permitted unless—</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(i) the advertisement is displayed with illumination on 19th February 2009; or(ii) the advertisement is first displayed after that date, and the advertisement most recently displayed was illuminated. <p>(d) An advertisement that—</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(i) comprises sequential displays; or(ii) otherwise includes moving parts or features; or(iii) features intermittent lighting in a manner designed to give the appearance of movement, <p>is not permitted unless—</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(aa) it is displayed on 19th February 2009 and falls within the description specified in any of sub-paragraphs (i) to (iii); or(bb) it is first displayed after that date, and the advertisement most recently displayed fell within any such description.”.
