**The Prison and Young Offenders Centre  
(Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 2009**

**Rule 69 (Police interviews)**

- 26.**—(1) Rule 69 (police interviews) shall be amended as follows:
- (2) In the heading after “police” insert “and other law enforcement agency”.
  - (3) In paragraph (1) for “Royal Ulster Constabulary” substitute “Police Service of Northern Ireland”.
  - (4) After paragraph (1) insert—
    - “(1A) A member of the Serious Organised Crime Agency’s staff designated under section 43 of the Serious Organised Crime and Police Act 2005(1), an officer of Her Majesty’s Revenue and Customs, or a member of the Security Service may, on production of an authorisation issued by or on behalf of a person specified in paragraph (1B), interview any prisoner willing to see him.
    - (1B) Those persons are—
      - (a) the Director General of the Serious Organised Crime Agency;
      - (b) the Commissioners of Her Majesty’s Revenue and Customs;
      - (c) the Director General of the Security Service.”.
