**The Personal Accounts Delivery Authority Winding Up
(Consequential Provisions) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010**

Made - - - - *11th June 2010*
Coming into operation *5th July 2010*

This Order is made in exercise of the powers conferred by section 65(6) of the Pensions (No. 2) Act (Northern Ireland) 2008⁽¹⁾.

The Secretary of State for Work and Pensions has made an Order⁽²⁾ containing provision under section 23(7) of the Pensions Act 2007⁽³⁾.

Accordingly the Department for Social Development makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Personal Accounts Delivery Authority Winding Up (Consequential Provisions) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010 and shall come into operation on 5th July 2010.

Repeals

2. The following provisions are repealed—
- (a) section 17 of the Pensions Act (Northern Ireland) 2008⁽⁴⁾ (management of the Authority);
 - (b) sections 65(1) to (5) and 66 to 68 of the Pensions (No. 2) Act (Northern Ireland) 2008 (functions of the Authority).
