**The Airfield Road Lower, Donnybrewer (Abandonment) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 2010**

*Made* - - - - *19th July 2010*

*Coming into operation* - *20th October 2010*

The Department for Regional Development<sup>(a)</sup> makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1) and (5) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993<sup>(b)</sup> and now vested in it<sup>(c)</sup>.

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order is of the opinion that the length of road described in the Schedule is not necessary for road traffic.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

No objection has been received.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as The Airfield Road Lower, Donnybrewer (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010 and shall come into operation on 20th October 2010.

**Application**

2. The length of road described in the Schedule is abandoned.

3.—(1) All existing cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus placed along, across, over or under the abandoned length of road shall be retained.

(2) All existing rights as to the use or maintenance of such cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus shall be preserved.

Article 2

### LENGTH OF ROAD TO BE ABANDONED

A length of Airfield Road Lower, Donnybrewer commencing at point 200 metres north of its junction with Lower Airfield Road extending for 506 metres in a northerly direction, including the level crossing, and more particularly delineated and shown cross-hatched on Map No. 10/1/20/09.
