

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM TO

The Depot Road, Belfast (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010

S. R. 2010 No. 254

1. Introduction

- 1.1. This Explanatory Memorandum has been prepared by the Department for Regional Development to accompany the Statutory Rule (details above) which is laid before the Northern Ireland Assembly.
- 1.2. The Statutory Rule is made under Article 68(1) and (5) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993 and is subject to the negative resolution procedure.

2. Purpose

- 2.1. The purpose of the rule is to abandon an area of 5177.1 square metres of road at Depot Road, Sydenham, Belfast, commencing at a point 20 metres north-east of its junction with Depot Road roundabout and extending in a north-easterly direction.

3. Background

- 3.1. The abandonment has been requested by DRD Roads Service, the owners of the bed and soil who wish to dispose of the road as it has been gated off for years. The Department is of the opinion that the area of road in question is no longer necessary for road traffic.

4. Consultation

- 4.1. The PSNI was consulted and has no objection and Belfast City Council was consulted but no reply has been received. A Notice in respect of the proposed abandonment was published in the local press for 2 successive weeks and statutory undertakers notified of the proposal.
- 4.2. No objection was received following publication of the notice.

5. Equality Impact

- 5.1. Consideration has been given to compliance with Section 75 of the Northern Ireland Act 1998. No equality issues have been identified by the Department and no issues were raised following the publication of the notice in the press.

- 6.1. A Regulatory Impact Assessment was not considered necessary as the proposal does not result in any costs or savings to business, charities or the voluntary bodies.
