

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM TO

The Redpoll Avenue, Lisburn (Footpaths) (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010

S.R. 2010 No. 429

1. Introduction

- 1.1. This Explanatory Memorandum has been prepared by the Department for Regional Development to accompany the Statutory Rule (details above) which is laid before the Northern Ireland Assembly.
- 1.2. The Statutory Rule is made under Article 68(1) and (5) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993 and is subject to the negative resolution procedure.

2. Purpose

- 2.1. The purpose of the Rule is to abandon an area of 160.7 square metres of footpath at Redpoll Avenue, Lisburn.

3. Background

- 3.1. The abandonment has been requested by the South Eastern Education and Library Board, who own the bed and soil of the footpaths, in connection with the provision of a new school.

4. Consultation

- 4.1. The PSNI has been consulted and has no objection. Lisburn City Council has been notified of the proposal. No response has been received.
- 4.2. A notice in respect of the proposed abandonment was published in the local press for 2 successive weeks, a notice was posted on site and the statutory undertakers were notified of the proposal. No objections were received.

5. Equality Impact

- 5.1. Consideration has been given to compliance with section 75 of the Northern Ireland Act 1998. No equality issues have been identified by the Department and no issues were raised following the publication of the notice in the press.

6. Regulatory Impact

- 6.1. A Regulatory Impact Assessment was not considered necessary as the proposal does not result in any cost or savings to business, charities or the voluntary bodies.

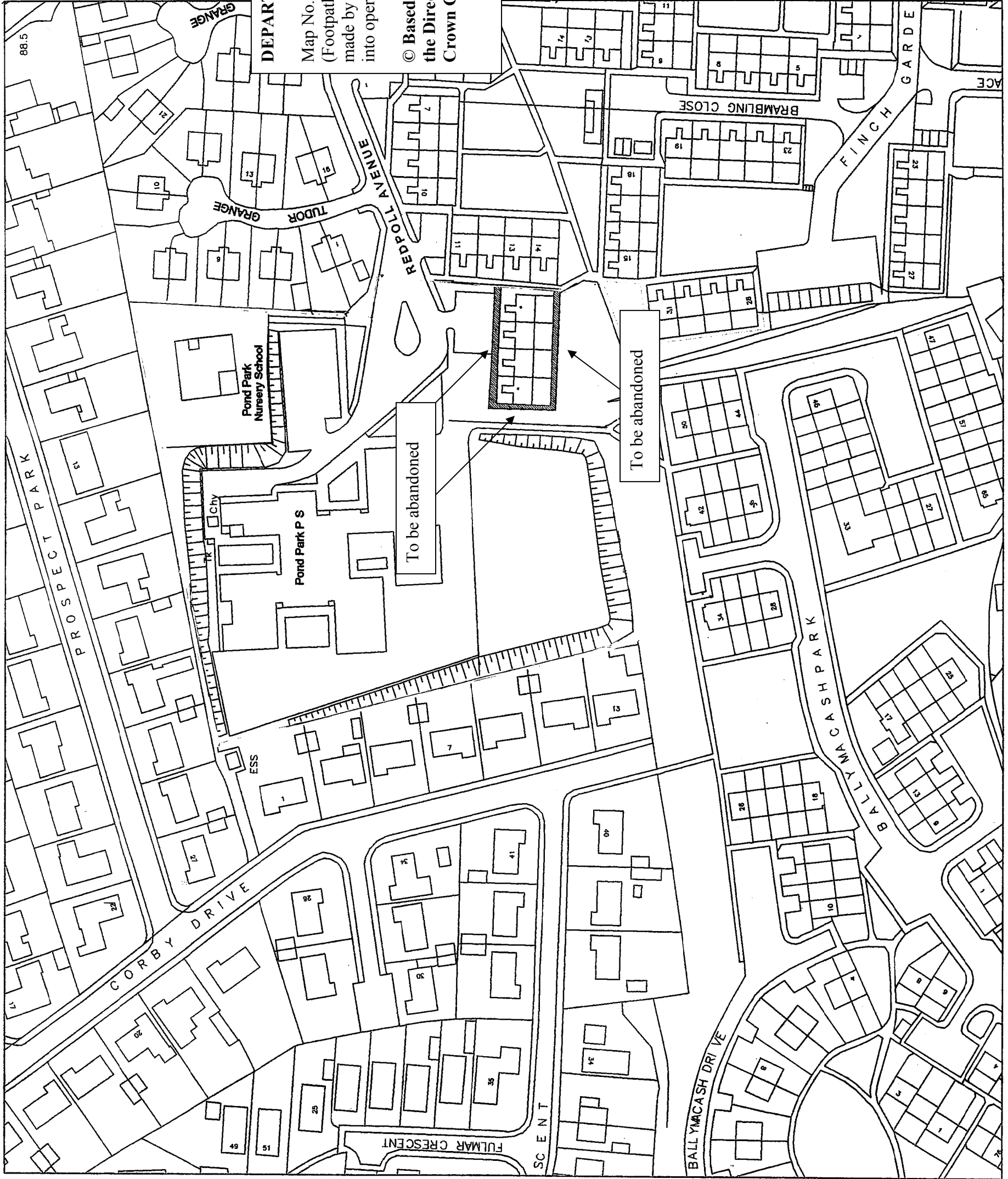
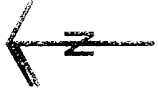
