**The One-Way Traffic (Belfast) (Amendment No. 2) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 2011**

*Made* - - - - - *21st March 2011*

*Coming into operation* - *12th April 2011*

The Department for Regional Development(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(b) and now vested in it(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a Notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

Seven objections were received and duly considered and no other representation has been received.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as The One-Way Traffic (Belfast) (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2011 and shall come into operation on 12th April 2011.

**Amendment**

2.—(1) The One-Way Traffic (Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 2009(d) shall be amended in accordance with paragraph (2).

(2) In Schedule 1, after item 213 add the following item—
