#### Citation, commencement and interpretation

**1.**—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the [<sup>F1</sup>RQIA] (Appointments and Procedure) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2011 and shall come into operation on 26th May 2011.

(2) In these Regulations "the principal Regulations" means the Regulation and Improvement Authority (Appointments and Procedure) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2004(**2**).
