

## SCHEDULE

### THE NEW ROADS TO BE CONSTRUCTED AS SPECIAL AND TRUNK ROADS AND PART OF THE M1 MOTORWAY AND T3

439 metres of new slip roads in the townlands of Tullynacross and Ballyskeagh and County of Down consisting of:

- (a) 99 metres of slip road adjacent to the Belfast bound carriageway of the M1 motorway extending in a generally north-easterly direction from a point on the M1 718 metres north-east of the centre point of Tullynacross Bridge, more particularly delineated, coloured red and marked S1 on the map;
- (b) 144 metres of slip road adjacent to the Belfast bound carriageway of the M1 motorway extending in a generally north-easterly direction from a point on the M1 966 metres north-east of the centre point of Tullynacross Bridge, more particularly delineated, coloured red and marked S2 on the map;
- (c) 161 metres of slip road adjacent to the Dungannon bound carriageway of the M1 motorway extending in a generally south-westerly direction from a point on the M1 700 metres north-east of the centre point of Tullynacross Bridge, more particularly delineated, coloured red and marked S3 on the map; and
- (d) 35 metres of slip road adjacent to the Dungannon bound carriageway of the M1 motorway extending in a generally south-westerly direction from a point on the M1 1010 metres north-east of the centre point of Tullynacross Bridge, more particularly delineated, coloured red and marked S4 on the map.
