The Malone Beeches, Belfast (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012

Made - - - - - *21st February 2012*

Coming into operation - *18th April 2012*

The Department for Regional Development^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1) and (5) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order proposes to abandon the areas of road described in the Schedule as they are not necessary.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

No objection has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Malone Beeches, Belfast (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012 and shall come into operation on 18th April 2012.

Application

2. The areas of road described in the Schedule are abandoned.

3.—(1) All existing cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus placed along, across, over or under the abandoned areas of road shall be retained.

(2) All existing rights as to the use or maintenance of such cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus shall be preserved.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

AREAS OF ROAD TO BE ABANDONED

Five areas of road at Malone Beeches, Belfast totalling 286.689 square metres, consisting of:—

- (a) 15.851 square metres of footway, commencing at a point 2 metres south of its junction with Norton Drive and extending for 8.88 metres in a southerly direction;
- (b) 95 square metres of footway and carriageway, commencing at a point 15 metres south of its junction with Norton Drive and extending for 22.603 metres in a generally easterly and southerly direction;
- (c) 23.174 square metres of footpath commencing at its junction with the footway at Norton Drive and extending for 14.446 metres in a south-westerly direction;
- (d) 129.109 square metres of parking bay and footway, commencing at a point 14.446 metres south of the footway at Norton Drive and extending for 15.38 metres in a southerly direction; and
- (e) 23.555 square metres of footway commencing at a point 29.826 metres south of the footway at Norton Drive and extending for 13.97 metres in a southerly and easterly direction;

more particularly delineated and shown hatched on Map No. 10/1/25/11.
