## The Statistics and Registration Service Act 2007 (Disclosure of Higher Education Student Information) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2013

## Interpretation

- **2.**—(1) The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954 (1) shall apply to these Regulations as it applies to an Act of the Assembly.
  - (2) In these Regulations
    - "the Act" means the Statistics and Registration Service Act 2007;
    - "institution of higher education" means an institution within the higher education sector within the meaning of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1993(2);
    - "mode of study" includes full and part time study and sandwich, block release and day release courses;
    - "student" means, for the purposes of these regulations, a person who undertakes a higher education course of study provided by an institution of higher education;
    - "unique student identifier" means the number which—
    - (a) is assigned to a student and is used by the Department for Employment and Learning for record management purposes;
    - (b) continues to apply to the student regardless of any change in the student's institution of higher education; and
    - (c) does not, without additional information, identify the individual.
