**The Waiting Restrictions (Holywood) (Amendment No. 2)
Order (Northern Ireland) 2013**

Made - - - - - *24th September 2013*

Coming into operation - *15th October 2013*

The Department for Regional Development(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(b) and now vested in it(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Waiting Restrictions (Holywood) (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2013 and shall come into operation on 15th October 2013.

Amendment

2. The Waiting Restrictions (Holywood) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012(d) is amended by the addition to the Schedule of the following item—

- “4. High Street (north-west side) – from a point 36.5 metres north-east of its junction with Ean Hill for a distance of 5 metres in a north-easterly direction.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order prohibits vehicles from waiting on the length of road specified in Article 2. Vehicles are excepted from the prohibition in certain circumstances.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be placed on the road.
