The Trunk Road T7 (A26 Dualling—Glarryford to A44 Drones Road Junction) Order (Northern Ireland) 2013

Made - - - - 28th November 2013

Coming into operation - 9th January 2014

The Department for Regional Development(**a**) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 14(1) and 68(1), (3) and (5) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993(**b**) and now vested in it(**c**).

The Department in accordance with Article 14(1) of that Order considers it expedient for the purpose of improving the trunk system that the road proposed to be constructed on the route described in Part I of the Schedule (in this Order referred to as "the new route") and the length of road described in Part II of the Schedule should be designated as trunk road.

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order proposes on completion of works providing alternative facilities for road traffic to—

- (a) stop-up the junction described in Part III of the Schedule;
- (b) stop-up the roads described in Part IV of the Schedule to road traffic; and
- (c) stop-up the road described in Part V of the Schedule to vehicular traffic.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

Twenty letters of objection were received and the Department considered the objections.

The Department having caused a local inquiry to be held into the objections to the proposed Order which were made and not withdrawn and having considered the report of the person who held the inquiry, now proposes to make the Order without modification.

Citation, commencement and interpretation

2.—(1) This Order may be cited as The Trunk Road T7 (A26 Dualling—Glarryford to A44 Drones Road Junction) Order (Northern Ireland) 2013 and shall come into operation on 9th January 2014.

(2) In this Order "Map 1" to "Map 6", inclusive means the sequence of drawings numbered from A26 S3 2911 to A26 S3 2916, inclusive, marked "The Trunk Road T7 (A26 Dualling—Glarryford to A44 Drones Road Junction) Order (Northern Ireland) 2013", copies of which have been deposited at the Department's Roads Service offices, Headquarters, Clarence Court, 10-18 Adelaide Street, Belfast BT2 8GB and Northern Division, County Hall, Castlerock Road, Coleraine BT51 3HS.

Direction as to trunk roads

- 3. The Department orders and directs as follows—
- (1) The new route described in Part I of the Schedule shall become trunk road and be part of the Belfast-Coleraine-Londonderry Trunk Road T7.
- (2) The lengths of road described in Part II of the Schedule shall become trunk road and be part of the Cloughmills-Ballycastle Trunk Road T18.

Stopping-up of roads

- **4.**—(1) The Department shall carry out such works as it considers necessary for the provision of alternative facilities for road traffic and on completion of the works of the works:
 - (a) the junction described in Part III of the Schedule shall be stopped-up;
 - (b) the roads described in Part IV of the Schedule shall be stopped-up to road traffic at the lines and at the point specified in that Part; and
 - (c) the road described in Part V of the Schedule shall be stopped-up to vehicular traffic at the points specified in that Part.
- (2) The Department shall carry out such works as it considers necessary to prevent or restrict to such extent as the Department thinks fit, access to the roads described in Part IV of the Schedule by road traffic and to the road described in Part V of the Schedule by vehicular traffic.

SCHEDULE

PART I

THE NEW ROUTE

7926 metres of new and upgraded road in the townlands of Tullyreagh, Drumakeely, Outal, Ballyhutherland, Frosses, Lisnasoo, Drumnaglea, Drumadoon, Ballylig, Broughanore and Ballynaloob, County of Antrim, comprising—

- (a) 777 metres of existing T7, A26 Crankill Road to be upgraded, from a point 640 metres south-east of its existing junction with B64 Station Road, to a point 137 metres northwest of that junction, more particularly delineated and coloured red on Map 1;
- (b) 1264 metres of new road, from a point on existing T7, A26 Crankill Road 137 metres north-west of its existing junction with B64 Station Road, to a point 1401 metres north-west of that junction, more particularly delineated and coloured red on Maps 1 and 2;
- (c) 52 metres of existing T7, A26 Frosses Road to be upgraded, from a point 1401 metres north-west of its existing junction with B64 Station Road, to a point 1453 metres north-west of that junction, more particularly delineated and coloured red on Map 2;
- (d) 1153 metres of new road, from a point on existing T7, A26 Frosses Road 1453 metres north-west of its existing junction with B64 Station Road, to a point 2606 metres north-west of that junction, more particularly delineated and coloured red on Map 3;
- (e) 33 metres of existing T7, A26 Frosses Road to be upgraded, from a point 727 metres south-east of its existing junction with C61 Lisnasoo Road, to a point 694 metres southeast of that junction, more particularly delineated and coloured red on Map 3;
- (f) 1023 metres of new road, from a point on existing T7, A26 Frosses Road 694 metres south-east of its existing junction with C61 Lisnasoo Road, to a point 329 metres northwest of that junction, more particularly delineated and coloured red on Maps 3 and 4;
- (g) 104 metres of existing T7, A26 Frosses Road to be upgraded, from a point 329 metres north-west of its existing junction with C61 Lisnasoo Road, to a point 433 metres north-west of that junction, more particularly delineated and coloured red on Map 4;
- (h) 536 metres of new road, from a point on existing T7, A26 Frosses Road from a point 433 metres north-west of its existing junction with C61 Lisnasoo Road, to a point 969 metres north-west of that junction, more particularly delineated and coloured red on Map 4;
- (i) 111 metres of existing T7, A26 Frosses Road to be upgraded, from a point 969 metres north-west of its existing junction with C61 Lisnasoo Road, to a point 1080 metres north-west of that junction, more particularly delineated and coloured red on Map 4;
- (j) 727 metres of new road, from a point on existing T7, A26 Frosses Road 1080 metres north- west of its existing junction with C61 Lisnasoo Road, to a point 1807 metres north-west of that junction, more particularly delineated and coloured red on Maps 4 and 5;
- (k) 1850 metres of existing T7, A26 Frosses Road to be upgraded, from a point 384 metres south-east of its existing junction with B94 Drumadoon Road, to a point 1466 metres north-west of that junction, more particularly delineated and coloured red on Maps 5 and 6;
- (l) 162 metres of new road (including a new roundabout), from a point on existing T7, A26 Frosses Road 30 metres south-east of its existing junction with A44 Drones Road, to a point 132 metres north-west of that junction, more particularly delineated and coloured red on Map 6; and
- (m) 134 metres of existing T7, A26 Frosses Road to be upgraded, from a point 132 metres north-west of its existing junction with A44 Drones Road, to a point 266 metres north-west of that junction, more particularly delineated and coloured red on Map 6.

PART II

LENGTHS OF NEW AND UPGRADED ROAD TO BE TRUNK ROAD AND PART OF THE T18

162 metres of new and upgraded road in the townland of Broughanore comprising—

- (a) 90 metres of new road, from a point 93 metres north of the existing junction of T7, A26 Frosses Road and T18, A44 Drones Road to a point 183 metres north of that junction, more particularly delineated and coloured pink on Map 6; and
- (b) 72 metres of existing T18, A44 Drones Road to be upgraded, from a point 183 metres north of its existing junction with T7, A26 Frosses Road, to a point 255 metres north of that junction, more particularly delineated and coloured pink on Map 6.

PART III

JUNCTION TO BE STOPPED-UP

B94 Drumadoon Road in the townland of Drumadoon, at its existing junction with T7, A26 Frosses Road, more particularly delineated, coloured brown and marked J1 on Map 5.

PART IV

ROADS TO BE STOPPED-UP TO ROAD TRAFFIC

- **1.** T7, A26 Crankill Road (southbound carriageway) in the townland of Tullyreagh, at a line extending from a point 495 metres south-east of its existing junction with B64 Springmount Road, to a point 338 metres south-east of that junction, more particularly delineated, coloured green and marked S1 on Map 1.
 - 2. T7, A26 Crankill Road/Frosses Road, in the townland of Drumakeely—
 - (a) the gap in the central reservation at a line opposite its existing junction with B64 Springmount Road, more particularly delineated, coloured green and marked S4 on Map 1; and
 - (b) the southbound carriageway, at a line extending from a point 121 metres north-west of its existing junction with B64 Springmount Road, to a point 428 metres north-west of that junction, more particularly delineated, coloured green and marked S5 on Map 1.

3. T7. A26 Frosses Road—

- (a) in the townland of Frosses, at a line extending from a point 681 metres south-east of its existing junction with C61 Lisnasoo Road, to a point 594 metres south-east of that junction, more particularly delineated, coloured green and marked S6 on Map 3;
- (b) in the townland of Lisnasoo, at a line extending from a point 138 metres north-west of its existing junction with C61 Lisnasoo Road, to a point 296 metres north-west of that junction, more particularly delineated, coloured green and marked S7 on Maps 3 and 4;
- (c) in the townlands of Lisnasoo and Drumnaglea, at a line extending from a point 454 metres north-west of its existing junction with C61 Lisnasoo Road, to a point 811 metres north-west of that junction, more particularly delineated, coloured green and marked S8 on Map 4;
- (d) in the townlands of Lisnasoo and Drumnaglea, at a line extending from a point 827 metres north-west of its existing junction with C61 Lisnasoo Road, to a point 942 metres north-west of that junction, more particularly delineated, coloured green and marked S9 on Map 4;

- (e) in the townland of Drumnaglea, at a line extending from a point 1105 metres north-west of its existing junction with C61 Lisnasoo Road, to a point 1217 metres north-west of that junction, more particularly delineated, coloured green and marked S10 on Map 4;
- (f) in the townland of Drumadoon, at a line extending from a point 561 metres south-east of its existing junction with B94 Drumadoon Road, to a point 291 metres south-east of that junction, more particularly delineated, coloured green and marked S11 on Map 5;
- (g) in the townland of Broughanore, at a line extending from a point 29 metres south-east of its existing junction with T18, A44 Drones Road, to a point 19 metres north-west of that junction, more particularly delineated, coloured green and marked S13 on Map 6; and
- (h) in the townland of Broughanore, at a line extending from a point 70 metres north-west of its existing junction with T18, A44 Drones Road, to a point 125 metres north-west of that junction, more particularly delineated, coloured green and marked S14 on Map 6.
- **4.** B93 Killagan Road, in the townland of Drumadoon, at a point 21 metres west of its existing junction with T7, A26 Frosses Road, more particularly delineated, coloured green and marked S12 on Map 5.
 - **5.** T18, A44 Drones Road in the townland of Broughanore—
 - (a) at a line extending from a point 30 metres north-east of its existing junction with T7, A26 Frosses Road, to a point 66 metres north of that junction, more particularly delineated, coloured green and marked S15 on Map 6; and
 - (b) at a line extending from a point 164 metres north of its existing junction with T7, A26 Frosses Road, to a point 185 metres north of that junction, more particularly delineated, coloured green and marked S16 on Map 6.

PART V

ROAD TO BE STOPPED-UP TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

- T7, A26 Crankill Road (southbound carriageway)—
 - (a) in the townland of Tullyreagh, at a point 281 metres south-east of its existing junction with B64 Springmount Road, more particularly delineated, coloured purple and marked S2 on Map 1; and
 - (b) in the townland of Drumakeely, at a point 262 metres south-east of its existing junction with B64 Springmount Road, more particularly delineated, coloured purple and marked S3 on Map 1.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order provides that—

- (a) 7926 metres of new and upgraded road including a new roundabout described in Part I of the Schedule, more particularly delineated and coloured red on the maps shall become trunk road and be part of the Belfast-Coleraine-Londonderry Trunk Road T7; and
- (b) 162 metres of new and upgraded road described in Part II of the Schedule, more particularly delineated and coloured pink on the maps shall become trunk road and be part of the Cloughmills-Ballycastle Trunk Road T18.

The Order also provides for the stopping-up of certain roads.

Other proposed new connecting roads together with new bridges which are not the subject of this Order are shown coloured blue and orange, respectively, on the maps for the purpose of clarification.
