**ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES**

**The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment  
No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2014**

*Made* - - - - - *8th April 2014*

*Coming into operation* - *29th April 2014*

The Department for Regional Development<sup>(a)</sup> makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 10(4), 13(1) and (16) of, and paragraph 5 of Schedule 4 to, the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997<sup>(b)</sup> and now vested in it<sup>(c)</sup>.

It appears to the Department to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles on the lengths of the roads specified in the Schedule.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

The Department in compliance with paragraph 3(4) of that Schedule, has taken such other steps as appear to the Department reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of the occupiers of land adjacent to the parking places the particulars specified in paragraph 3(2) of that Schedule.

No written objections or other representations have been received.

The Department has modified the draft Order.

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order may be cited as The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2014 and shall come into operation on 29th April 2014.

  - (iii) item no 722 relating to Drumbreda Avenue, Armagh.

## SCHEDULE

Article 2 (2)

### Unlimited Waiting

- “984. Rathfriland Street, Banbridge (north-east side) - from a point 15 metres south-east of its junction with Bridge Street, for a distance of 6 metres in a south-easterly direction.
- 985. Rosebery Road, Belfast (east side) – from a point 20 metres south of its junction with Willowfield Parade, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a southerly direction.
- 986. Tennent Street, Belfast (west side) – from a point 74 metres south of its junction with Crumlin Road, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a southerly direction.
- 987. Woodvale Drive, Belfast (west side) – from a point 101 metres south of its junction with Twaddell Avenue, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a southerly direction.
- 988. Orritor Crescent, Cookstown (south side) – from a point 48 metres south of its junction with Orritor Street, for a distance of 6.5 metres in a westerly direction.
- 989. Circular Road, Larne (west side) – from a point 39 metres south-west of its junction with Drummond Court, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a south-westerly direction.
- 990. Lurgan Tarry, Lurgan (north-east side) - from a point 90 metres south-east of its junction with Levin Road, for a distance of 6 metres in a south-easterly direction.
- 991. Cushier Green, Mountnorris (south-east side) - from a point 42 metres north-east of its junction with Main Street, for a distance of 6 metres in a north-easterly direction.
- 992. Thomas Street, Portadown (west side) – from a point 25 metres south of its junction with Carleton Street, for a distance of 6 metres in a southerly direction.”

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order amends The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2006.

The amendments provide for the introduction of parking places with unlimited waiting on the lengths of the road specified in the Schedule, and the removal of the parking places referred to in Article 2(2).
