The Products Containing Meat etc. Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2014

Parts of the carcase in uncooked regulated products

- **5.**—(1) Subject to paragraph (3), a person must not sell an uncooked regulated product if any part of a carcase specified in paragraph (2) has been used as an ingredient in the preparation of that product.
- (2) The specified parts of a carcase are the brains, feet, large intestine, lungs, oesophagus, rectum, small intestine, spinal cord, spleen, stomach, testicles and udder from any mammalian species.
- (3) The prohibition in paragraph (1) does not extend to the use of a mammalian large or small intestine solely as a sausage skin.
- (4) In this regulation "sausage" includes chipolata, frankfurter, link, salami and any similar product.
