CALCULATION OF CAPITAL – REPRESENTATION (HIGHER COURTS)

**Disregard of certain welfare and other payments**

- 49.** In calculating the disposable capital of the person concerned, there shall be disregarded—
- (a) any extra-statutory job grant paid by the Department for Social Development;
  - (b) any payment made out of the social fund under Part 8 of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits (Northern Ireland) Act 1992 <sup>M1</sup>; and
  - (c) any arrears of direct payments made under regulations made under section 8(1) of the Carers and Direct Payments Act (Northern Ireland) 2002 <sup>M2</sup>.
