LICENSING OF PAVEMENT CAFÉS

The Licensing of Pavement Cafés (Form of Licence) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2016

Made - - - - 2nd March 2016

Coming into operation 1st October 2016

The Department for Social Development makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 5(1) of the Licensing of Pavement Cafés Act (Northern Ireland) 2014(1) and now vested in it(2).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Licensing of Pavement Cafés (Form of Licence) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2016 and shall come into operation on 1st October 2016.

Form of licence for Pavement Cafés

2. A pavement café licence shall be in the form set out in the Schedule.
