The Family Proceedings (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 2016

Made--4th July 2016Coming into operation in accordance with Rule 1

The Family Proceedings Rules Committee makes the following Rules in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 12 of the Family Law (Northern Ireland) Order 1993(1).

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These Rules may be cited as the Family Proceedings (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 2016 and shall come into operation on the same day as section 1 of the Justice Act (Northern Ireland) 2015(**2**).

- (2) In these Rules—
 - (a) "the principal Rules" means the Family Proceedings Rules (Northern Ireland) 1996(3); and
 - (b) a reference to an Order, rule, Appendix or Form is a reference to that Order, rule, Appendix or Form so numbered in the principal Rules.

- (29) In rule 8.27, for "a designated" substitute "the".
- (30) In rule 8.31, in the heading, omit "designated".
- (31) In rule 8.32, in the heading, omit "designated".
- (32) In Appendix 1-
 - (a) in Forms M1 to M4, in the title, omit "for the Division of";
 - (b) in Form M8, for "designated" substitute "the";
 - (c) in Forms M18, M20, M21, M26 and M26A, in the title, omit "for the Division of";
 - (d) in Forms C1 to C3, in the title, omit "Designated" and "for the Division of";
 - (e) in Form C3A, in the title, omit "Divorce" and "for the Division of";
 - (f) in Forms C4, C6 to C17 and C20 to C42, in the title, omit "Designated" and "for the Division of";
 - (g) in the title of Form C43, omit "Designated" and, in each place where it occurs, "for the Division of";
 - (h) in the title of Forms F1 to F8, omit "Designated" and "for the Division of";
 - (i) in the title of Form F9, omit "Designated" and, in each place where it occurs, "for the Division of";
 - (j) in the title of Forms F10, F11 and F13 to F17, omit "for the Division of"; and
 - (k) in the title of Forms A1 and A2, omit "for the Division of";

These Rules amend the Family Proceedings Rules (Northern Ireland) 1996 (S.R. 1996 No.322) to take account of Part 1 of and Schedule 1 to the Justice Act (Northern Ireland) 2015 which creates a single jurisdiction for county courts and magistrates' courts whereby the jurisdiction and powers of those courts are exercisable throughout the whole of Northern Ireland.
