**ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES**

**The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Newtownabbey)  
(Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016**

*Made* - - - - - *20th October 2016*

*Coming into operation* - *10th November 2016*

The Department for Infrastructure<sup>(a)</sup> makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997<sup>(b)</sup> and now vested in it<sup>(c)</sup>.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Newtownabbey) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016 and shall come into operation on 10th November 2016.

**Amendments**

2.—(1) The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Newtownabbey) Order (Northern Ireland) 2015<sup>(d)</sup> is amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).

(2) For Article 11 substitute the following Article—

**“Lengths of road on which vehicles must not wait**

**11.** Save as provided in Article 12, a person shall not cause or permit a vehicle to wait —

- (a) at any time on the lengths of roads specified in Part 1 of Schedule 2; or
- (b) during the hours between 9.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on the days Monday to Friday inclusive on the lengths of road specified in Part 2 of Schedule 2.”

(3) For Schedule 2 substitute the Schedule contained in the Schedule to this Order.

### “SCHEDULE 2

Article 11

#### Waiting Restrictions in Newtownabbey

##### PART 1

###### No Waiting at any time — Loading and unloading permitted

1. The bus turning circle located opposite No. 698 Shore Road, (southern kerb line) – from the entrance junction with Shore Road to the exit junction with Shore Road for a distance of 91 metres broken only by the existing bus stop markings.
2. Farrier Court (north side) – from a point 25.5 metres east of its junction with Antrim Road in an easterly and then northerly direction for a distance of 30 metres.
3. Farrier Court (north side) – from a point 5.5 metres south of the northern end of the turning head adjacent to Church Road in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 37 metres.
4. McKinney Road (west side) – from its junction with Mallusk Road for a distance of 150 metres in a southerly direction.
5. Shore Road, Whiteabbey Village (north-west side) – from a point 15 metres south-west of its junction with Chestnut Hill for a distance of 75 metres in a south-westerly direction.
6. Portland Avenue (north side) – from a point 15 metres west of its junction with Carnmoney Road to a point 15 metres east of its junction with Ballyclare Road.
7. Portland Avenue (south side) – from a point 15 metres west of its junction with Carnmoney Road for a distance of 12 metres in a westerly direction.
8. Portland Avenue (south side) – from a point 32.8 metres west of its junction with Carnmoney Road for a distance of 14 metres in a westerly direction.
9. Portland Avenue (south side) – from a point 52.7 metres west of its junction with Carnmoney Road for a distance of 7 metres in a westerly direction.
10. Portland Avenue (south side) – from a point 77.7 metres west of its junction with Carnmoney Road for a distance of 7.5 metres in a westerly direction.

##### PART 2

###### No Waiting Monday to Friday 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. — Loading and unloading permitted

1. Old Manse Road (north-east side) – from a point 20 metres north-west of its junction with Shore Road for a distance of 25 metres in a north-westerly direction.
2. Old Manse Road (south-west side) – from a point 35 metres north-west of its junction with Shore Road for a distance of 40 metres in a north-westerly direction.”

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order amends The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Newtownabbey) Order (Northern Ireland) 2015 (“the Order”) by the addition of a no waiting restriction on the lengths of road specified in Part 2 of the Schedule. Vehicles are excepted from the restriction in certain circumstances.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be placed on the road.
