**The Child Support (Deduction from Earnings Orders,
Amendment and Modification and Miscellaneous
Amendments) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2016**

Amendment of the Child Support (Collection and Enforcement) Regulations

2. In regulation 20(1)(1) of the Child Support (Collection and Enforcement) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1992 (discharge of deductions from earnings orders)—

- (a) omit “or” after sub-paragraph (f); and
- (b) after sub-paragraph (g) add—

“; or

- (h) it is appropriate to discharge the order in a case where liability has ceased to accrue under the maintenance assessment or maintenance calculation in respect of which the order is made because the power under paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 2 to the Child Maintenance Act (Northern Ireland) 2008 (power to require a decision about whether to stay in the statutory scheme) has been exercised in relation to the case.”.
