ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment
No. 4) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016**

Made - - - - - *6th December 2016*

Coming into operation - *28th December 2016*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 10(4), 13(1) and (16) of, and paragraph 5 of Schedule 4 to, the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

It appears to the Department to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles on the lengths of the roads specified in the Schedule.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

The Department in compliance with paragraph 3(4) of that Schedule, has taken such other steps as appear to the Department reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of the occupiers of land adjacent to the parking places the particulars specified in paragraph 3(2) of that Schedule.

Two objections and one representation have been received and duly considered.

The Department has modified the draft Order.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment No. 4) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016 and shall come into operation on 28th December 2016.

Amendments

2.—(1) The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016^(a) is amended in accordance with paragraph (2).

(2) In Schedule 1—

(a) delete the following—

- (i) item no. 389 relating to Castlereagh Place, Belfast;
- (ii) item no. 480 relating to Killowen Street, Belfast;
- (iii) item no. 755 relating to Park Crescent, Comber;
- (iv) item no. 842 relating to Killyleagh Street, Crossgar;
- (v) item no. 930 relating to John Street, Downpatrick;
- (vi) item no. 962 relating to Saul Street, Downpatrick;
- (vii) item no. 1017 relating to Cherryhill Gardens, Dundonald; and
- (viii) item no. 1028 relating to Church Avenue, Dundrum.

(b) for item no. 1030 substitute the following item—

“1030. Church Avenue, Dundrum, Newcastle (south side) – from a point 81.6 metres north-west of its junction with Church View, for a distance of 3.6 metres in a south-westerly direction.”

(c) add the items set out in the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

Article 2(2)(c)

Unlimited Waiting

- “2360. Kilbride Gardens, Antrim (south side) – from a point 71 metres west of its junction with Donegore Drive, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a westerly direction.
- 2361. North Street, Ballycastle (north-east side) (2 bays) – from a point 33 metres south-east of its junction with Bayview Road, for a distance of 6.5 metres in a south-easterly direction.
- 2362. Abbey Street, Bangor (north-west side of the north-west carriageway in a lay-by) – from a point 213.7 metres north-east of its junction with Brunswick Road, for a distance of 6 metres in a north-easterly direction.
- 2363. Ruby Street, Bangor (west side) – from a point 25.5 metres south of its junction with Hamilton Road, for a distance of 6 metres in a southerly direction.
- 2364. Seacliff Road, Bangor (north-west side) – from a point 363 metres south-west of its junction with Ward Avenue, for a distance of 7.1 metres in a south-westerly direction.
- 2365. Castlereagh Place, Belfast (south-east side) – from a point 27 metres north-east of its junction with Pottinger Street, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a north-easterly direction.
- 2366. Castlereagh Place, Belfast (south-east side) – from a point 50 metres south-west of its junction with Castlereagh Street, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a south-westerly direction.
- 2367. Clarawood Park, Belfast (south-west side) – from a point 75 metres north-west of its junction with Clarawood Grove, for a distance of 6.6 metres in a north-westerly direction.
- 2368. Halstein Drive, Belfast (south-east side) – from a point 32 metres north-east of its junction with Sandown Road, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a north-easterly direction.
- 2369. Croft Road, Carnlough (south-west side) – from a point 40 metres south-east of its junction with Croft Avenue, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a south-easterly direction.
- 2370. Enler Park East, Dundonald (south-east side) – from a point 102 metres south-west of its junction with Enler East Walk, for a distance of 3 metres in a south-westerly direction.
- 2371. Galway Park, Dundonald (west side) – from a point 188 metres east of its junction with Private Avenue, for a distance of 6.6 metres in a south-easterly direction.
- 2372. Hawthorne Grove, Glynn, Larne (south-east side) – from a point 178 metres east of its junction with Glenburn Road, for a distance of 3 metres in an easterly direction.
- 2373. Downpatrick Road, Killyleagh (north-west side) – from a point 21 metres south-west of its junction with Plantation Street, for a distance of 6 metres in a south-westerly direction.
- 2374. Islandmagee Road, Whitehead (north-east side) – from a point 80 metres south-east of its junction with Ransevyn Drive, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a south-easterly direction.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016 by the introduction of parking places with unlimited waiting on the lengths of the roads specified in the Schedule. The Order will also remove the parking places referred to in Article 2(2)(a) and amend the item specified in Article 2(2)(b).
