**The Prohibition of Waiting (Schools) (Amendment) Order
(Northern Ireland) 2017**

Made - - - - - *30th June 2017*

Coming into operation - *21st July 2017*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Prohibition of Waiting (Schools) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2017 and shall come into operation on 21st July 2017.

Amendment

2. The Prohibition of Waiting (Schools) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2015^(d) is amended by the addition to Schedule 2 of the following item—

“27.	Sallagh Park, Larne (west side) – from a point 123 metres north of its junction with Laharna Avenue for a distance of 45 metres in a northerly direction.	8.30 a.m. to 9.15 a.m. and 1.30 p.m. to 3.15 p.m.	Monday to Friday inclusive	31st August to 30th June”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Prohibition of Waiting (Schools) Order (Northern Ireland) 2015 (“the Order”) by the addition to Schedule 2 of the item specified in Article 2.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of this Order will in due course be placed on the road.
