ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

The Cycle Routes (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2017

Made - - - - *30th June 2017*

Coming into operation - *21st July 2017*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objections or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Cycle Routes (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2017 and shall come into operation on 21st July 2017.

Amendments

2. The Cycle Routes Order (Northern Ireland) 2008^(d) is amended by the addition to Schedule 2 of the following items—

- “492. The eastern footway of Arleston Road, Unclassified No. 1701, Omagh from its junction with the C625 Old Mountfield Road for a distance of 25 metres in a south-easterly direction.
- 493. The western footway of the B1528 Donaghanie Road, Omagh from its junction with Cranny Bridge roundabout for a distance of 31 metres in a south-easterly direction.
- 494. The southern footway of the B4 Hospital Road, Omagh from its junction with Cranny Bridge roundabout for a distance of 46 metres in a north-westerly direction.

495. The northern footway of the B4 Hospital Road, Omagh from its junction with Riverview Road, Unclassified No. 1701, to a point 19 metres south-east of that junction.
496. The southern footway of the C625 Old Mountfield Road, Omagh from its junction with Kylemore Gardens, Unclassified No. 3018, to its junction with Arleston Road, Unclassified No. 1701.
497. The western footway of Riverview Road, Unclassified No. 1701, Omagh from a point 12 metres north east of its junction with the B4 Hospital Road, Omagh for a distance of 30 metres in a north-easterly direction.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Cycle Route Order (Northern Ireland) 2008 (“the Order”) by the addition of two-way shared cycle tracks on the lengths of footway specified in Article 2.

Any person who acts in contravention of any provision of the Order relating to cycle tracks shall be guilty of an offence under the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 (“the Regulation Order”) and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£1,000), in accordance with the Road Traffic Offenders (Northern Ireland) Order 1996 as amended by the Regulation Order.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be placed on the roads.
