SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS AND PENSIONS

Age addition to long-term incapacity benefit

16.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), in regulation 9(2) of the Social Security (Incapacity Benefit) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1994⁽¹⁾ (increase in rate of incapacity benefit where beneficiary is under prescribed age on the qualifying date)—

- (a) in sub-paragraph (a) for “£21·50” substitute “£21·70”; and
- (b) in sub-paragraph (b) for “£10·80” substitute “£10·90”.

(2) In the case of a claimant entitled to long-term incapacity benefit the sums specified in regulation 9(2)(a) and (b) of those Regulations shall be increased to £11·25 and £6·25 respectively.
