The Environmental Protection (Microbeads) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2019

Offences and penalties

- **3.**—(1) A person who, in the manufacture of any rinse-off personal care product, uses microbeads as an ingredient of that product is guilty of an offence.
- (2) A person who supplies or offers to supply any rinse-off personal care product containing microbeads is guilty of an offence.
 - (3) A person guilty of an offence under paragraph (1) or (2) is liable—
 - (a) on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding level 5 on the standard scale; or
 - (b) on conviction on indictment, to a term of imprisonment not exceeding 2 years, or to a fine or to both.
- (4) A person who fails, without reasonable excuse, to comply with a requirement to provide information imposed under regulation 4(2) is guilty of an offence and is liable—
 - (a) on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 5 on the standard scale; or
 - (b) on conviction on indictment, to a term of imprisonment not exceeding 2 years, or to a fine or to both.
