The Food (Miscellaneous Amendments and Revocations) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2019

PART 2

Amendments to Food and Feed legislation

The Preserved Sardines (Marketing Standards) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990

2.—(1) The Preserved Sardines (Marketing Standards) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990⁽¹⁾ are amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).

(2) In regulation 2(1), in the definition of “the Council Regulation”, at the end insert “and trade descriptions for preserved sardines and sardine-type products, as last amended by [Commission Regulation \(EC\) No 1345/2008](#)⁽²⁾”.

(3) In the Schedule, after item 7 in the table insert—

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The Food (Lot Marking) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1996

The Medical Food Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2000

Processed Cereal-based Foods and Baby Foods for Infants and Young Children Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2003

“(1) A person who contravenes or fails to comply with any of the EU provisions specified in paragraph (2) is guilty of an offence.”
