**The Footpath to the rear of Albert Street, Quadrant Place and
Cullingtree Road, Belfast (Abandonment) Order (Northern
Ireland) 2020**

Made - - - - *18th August 2020*

Coming into operation - *7th October 2020*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1) and (5) of The Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order proposes to abandon the area of road described in the Schedule as it is not necessary.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

No objection has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Footpath to the rear of Albert Street, Quadrant Place and Cullingtree Road, Belfast (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2020 and shall come into operation on 7th October 2020.

Application

2. The area of road described in the Schedule is abandoned.

3.—(1) All existing cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus placed along, across, over or under the abandoned area of road shall be retained.

(2) All existing rights as to the use or maintenance of such cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus shall be preserved.

Article 2

AREA OF ROAD TO BE ABANDONED

An area of 357.9 square metres of road consisting of a footpath on the western side of the Westlink, extending from its junction with Albert Street northwards for a distance of 115 metres to the south side of the Westlink footbridge between Durham Street and Cullingtree Road, more particularly delineated and shown hatched and coloured red on map number IN1/19/337774.
