### FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The Financial Assistance (Coronavirus) (Airports) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2021

Made - - - - 29th March 2021
Coming into operation 31st March 2021

The Department of Finance(1) makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1(2) of the Financial Assistance (Northern Ireland) Act 2009(2):

#### Citation and commencement

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as The Financial Assistance (Coronavirus) (Airports) (Amendment) (Northern Ireland) Regulations 2021 and shall come into operation on 31st March 2021.

# Amendment of The Financial Assistance (Coronavirus) (Airports) (Northern Ireland) Scheme 2020

- **2.** The Financial Assistance (Coronavirus) (Airports) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2020(**3**) are amended in accordance with regulation 3.
- **3.** In paragraph 4(2) of the Schedule to The Financial Assistance (Coronavirus) (Airports) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2020, for "is not to exceed £7.8m" substitute "is not to exceed £10,030,000.00".

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**
