It also amends the 1996 Order to introduce some new fees and make other amendments in consequence of amendments to the Licensing (Northern Ireland) Order 1996 (S.I. 1996 No. 3158) (N.I. 22)) and the Registration of Clubs (Northern Ireland) Order 1996 (S.I. 1996 No. 3159) (N.I. 23)) made by the Licensing and Registraton of Clubs (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021 (c.7).
