# The Licensing (Form of Licence) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2023

Made - - - - 24th April 2023

Coming into operation 31st May 2023

The Department for Communities(1) makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 33 of the Licensing (Northern Ireland) Order 1996(2) and now vested in it(3).

#### Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Licensing (Form of Licence) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2023 and come into operation on 31st May 2023.

#### Amendment to the Licensing (Form of Licence) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1997

- **2.**—(1) The Licensing (Form of Licence) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1997(4) are amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) to (6).
- (2) In Part I of Form 1 of the Schedule (Kind of Premises for which Licence Granted), after "[an outdoor stadium]" insert "[premises in which the business of producing intoxicating liquor is carried on in accordance with any certificate of registration, licence or other authorisation which is required by a statutory provision.]".
- (3) In Part III of Form 1 of the Schedule (Orders Made in Relation to the Premises as to Suitability for Extension Licences, Alternative or Additional Permitted Hours etc.)—

#### Local producer's premises: authorisation for on-sales

#### Warning to the Licence Holder

- This authorisation does not authorise the sale of intoxicating liquor on Christmas Day.
- This authorisation permits the purchase of intoxicating liquor in the part or parts of the premises to which an order under Article 52E applies only on the day, and during the hours specified in the authorisation, and its consumption during those hours and the first 60 minutes after the conclusion of those hours.
- 3. A notice in the form and manner, and containing the information prescribed in the Licensing (Notice Relating to Local Producer's Licence) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2022 must be displayed at all times in the part of the premises to which the order under Article 52E applies. Where a notice in the prescribed form is not displayed the licence holder is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.

PART III (Article 58B)

#### Authorisations for underage functions

of a licence authorising the sale of intoxicating liquor in the premises at

being premises of a kind mentioned in Article 58A(5) of the Licensing (Northern Ireland) Order 1996, for [part of] which an order is in force under Article 58A of the said Order, is granted authorisation to hold an underage function in the following specified part(s) of those premises namely—

[between the hours of and on the day of 20 ] [between the hours of on the day of 20 and ending no later than 1 in the morning of the next day], subject to the following conditions:

- that each dispenser of intoxicating liquor in the part of the premises for which the authorisation is in force is incapable of operation;
- 2. access to any other container of intoxicating liquor in that part must be prevented;
- [include any other conditions imposed by a court].

## Warning to the Licence Holder

- If a condition is contravened, the holder of the licence is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.
- This authorisation does not permit a licence holder to allow any person under the age of 18 attending an underage function to remain in the premises longer than 30 minutes after the authorisation has ceased.
- 3. This authorisation does not permit, during the period for which an authorisation is in force, for the holder of the licence, personally or by a servant or agent, to sell intoxicating liquor to, or make it available for purchase by a person aged 18 or over in the part of the premises for which the authorisation is in force.

A person who contravenes this condition is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.

4. It also does not permit a person aged 18 or over to consume intoxicating liquor in the part of the premises for which the authorisation is in force, during the period for which it is in force, or gaming machines in any part of licensed premises in which an authorisation is in force, during the period for which it is in force. A person who contravenes this condition is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Licensing (Form of Licence) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1997, to take account of changes required to the form of licence as a result of provisions within the Licensing and Registration of Clubs (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland) 2021. The relevant provisions authorise underage functions in specified licensed premises, further later opening for public houses and hotels, and the retail sale and consumption of intoxicating liquor in a local producer's premises under the Licensing (Northern Ireland) Order 1996.

These Regulations also remove references relating to provisions which removed additional restrictions on Good Friday, Easter Day and late night permitted hours on a Sunday.
