

Employment under Local and Public Authorities.

MADE BY THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE JOINT COMMITTEE
AND THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR FOR NORTHERN IRELAND,
ACTING JOINTLY, UNDER PARAGRAPH (d) OF PART I. OF THE
FIRST SCHEDULE TO THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE
ACT, 1924.

The National Health Insurance Joint Committee and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by paragraph (d) of Part I. of the First Schedule to the National Health Insurance Act, 1924 (14 & 15 Geo. 5, c. 38) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and by article 5 of the National Health Insurance (Joint Committee) Regulations, 1924, hereby make the following Order :—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the National Health Insurance (Employment under Local and Public Authorities) Order (Northern Ireland), 1924.

(2) In this Order the expression "Office" includes any office, situation, or employment, and the expression "pensionable office" means an office coming within the provisions of any Act authorising the grant of a superannuation allowance.

(3) The Interpretation Act, 1889, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. Employment of any class specified in the Schedule to this Order under any local or other public authority shall be deemed not to be employment within the meaning of the Act.

3. The National Health Insurance (Employment under Local and Public Authorities) Exclusion Order (Ireland), 1914 (S. R. & O., 1914, No. 1508), and the National Health Insurance (Employment under Local and Public Authorities) Order (Ireland) No. 2, 1914 (S. R. & O., 1915, No. 627), are hereby revoked, but without prejudice to any right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued or incurred thereunder.

SCHEDULE.

Employment under any Local or Other Public Authority :—

- (a) In any pensionable office in a permanent capacity ;
- (b) As chaplain or other minister of religion ;
- (c) As duly qualified medical practitioner ;
- (d) As coroner or deputy coroner ;
- (e) As public analyst ;
- (f) As public vaccinator ;
- (g) As registrar, assistant registrar, or deputy registrar of Births, Marriages, and Deaths ;

(h) Under a contract of apprenticeship without money payment :
 Employment under a Board of Guardians :—
 (a) As a pauper ;
 (b) In rearing boarded-out pauper children :
 Employment under any Local or other Public Authority not being employment within the meaning of Part I. (a), (b), (c), or (e) of the First Schedule to the Act, in the execution of contracts not requiring personal service on the part of the employed person.
 Employment as a pilot under the Londonderry Port and Harbour Commissioners.

OLD AGE PENSIONS. Consolidated Regulations.

MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND
 IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS
 FOR NORTHERN IRELAND HEREBY IN PURSUANCE OF THE
 OLD AGE PENSIONS ACTS, 1908 TO 1919 (a) AND THE BLIND
 PERSONS ACT, 1920 (b).

GENERAL PROVISIONS.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Old Age Pensions Consolidated Regulations (N.I.), 1925. Short Title.

2.—(1) In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires— Interpre-
tation.

“ The Act of 1908 ” means the Old Age Pensions Act, 1908, “ the Act of 1911 ” means the Old Age Pensions Act, 1911, “ the Act of 1919 ” means the Old Age Pensions Act, 1919, “ the Act of 1920 ” means the Blind Persons Act, 1920; and “ the Acts ” means the Old Age Pensions Acts, 1908 to 1919, and the Blind Persons Act, 1920 :

“ The Ministry ” means the Ministry of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland acting as the Central Pension Authority within the meaning of the Act of 1908, and “ the Ministry of Finance ” means the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland :
