## 1934. No. 111.

1. In pursuance of sub-section (5) of section 98 of the Friendly Societies Act, 1896, Regulation 22 of the National Health Insurance (Deposit Contributors) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1925, Regulation 3 of the Contributory Pensions (Requisition for Death Certificates) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1926, and Regulation 30 of the Savings Certificates Regulations, 1933, I, the Registrar-General for Northern Ireland, hereby approve of the forms set forth in the Schedule hereto for use as follows:—

Form A. for applications for certificates of birth required for the purposes of—

- (a) the Friendly Societies Act, 1896; and
- (b) the Savings Certificates Regulations, 1933.

Form B. for applications for certificates of death required for the purposes of—

- (a) the Friendly Societies Act, 1896;
- (b) the National Health Insurance Act, 1924, in cases of deaths of Deposit Contributors;
- (c) the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act (Northern Ireland), 1925; and
- (d) the Savings Certificates Regulations, 1933.

BY THE GOVERNOR AND PRIVY COUNCIL OF NORTHERN IRELAND.  
ABERCORN.

WHEREAS by the Representation of the People Act (Northern Ireland), 1928, (in this Order referred to as "the Act of 1928") the Representation of the People Act, 1918, as amended by subsequent enactments, (in this Order referred to as "the principal Act") has been amended in its application to the parliamentary and local government franchises in Northern Ireland :

And whereas by Sub-Section (2) of Section 6 of the Act of 1928 it is enacted that the Governor of Northern Ireland may by Order in the Privy Council of Northern Ireland prescribe the forms to be used for the purposes of registration under the Representation of the People Acts, 1918 to 1922, and the Act of 1928, and make (with the approval of the Secretary of State) such alterations of the forms prescribed under Section 13 of the principal Act, or in the rules in force under that section in their application to the parliamentary and local government franchises in Northern Ireland, as appear to the said Governor to be necessary or proper for the purpose of giving effect to the provisions of the Act of 1928 :

And whereas by Sub-Section (7) of Section 4 of the principal Act as amended by the Act of 1928 (which said Section relates to the local government franchise of companies) it is enacted that the Governor of Northern Ireland may by Order in the Privy Council of Northern Ireland make provision (a) with respect to the form of the questions which, in the case of persons registered under that Section, may be asked of voters at a poll and with
