Sale of Ice-Cream Act, 1937: Appointed Day.

ORDER, DATED THE 27TH DAY OF MAY, 1938, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION SIXTEEN OF THE SALE OF ICE-CREAM ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1937.

1938. No. 68.

WHEREAS by Section Sixteen of the Sale of Ice-Cream Act (Northern Ireland), 1937, (hereinafter referred to as "The Act") it is provided that the Act shall come into operation on the appointed day, and that the appointed day for the purposes of the Act shall be such day as the Minister of Agriculture, after consultation with the Minister of Home Affairs, may appoint, and that different days may be appointed for different purposes and different provisions of the Act :

And whereas it is expedient that a day be appointed for the coming into operation of the provisions of the Act :

Now, therefore, I, the Right Honourable Sir Basil Stanlake Brooke, Bart., Minister of Agriculture, after consultation with the Minister of Home Affairs, hereby appoint the fifteenth day of June, 1938, to be the appointed day for the coming into operation of the provisions of the Act.
