Ballykelly), Edenmore, Farlow, Glebe (E.D. Ballykelly), Killane, Lisnakilly, Lomond, Moneyrannell, Mulkeeragh (E.D. Ballykelly), Mullagh, Myroe Level, Newtown Limavady alias Rathbrady Beg, Rascahan, Rathbrady More, Shanreagh, Tamlaght (E.D. Ballykelly), Terrydremont North, Terrydremont South, Tully, Tullyhoe, all in the Barony of Keenaght, in the Administrative County of Londonderry.

### Short Title and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Importation of Forest Trees (Prohibition) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1949, and shall come into force on the 15th day of October, nineteen hundred and forty-nine.

### Interpretation

- 2.—(1) In this Order :—
  - "Ministry" means the Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland.
  - "Inspector" means an Inspector or other Authorised Officer of the Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland.
