

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that if within the time above specified the requirements contained in this Notice are not complied with the said County Council may take such action and execute all such works as are necessary for causing the watercourse to be scoured out and cleansed in a proper manner; and that the whole or any part of the expenses incurred by the County Council in executing such works shall, if they so determine, be a debt due to the County Council by you and may, without prejudice to any other remedy, be recovered from you summarily as a civil debt due to the County Council.

IF YOU OBJECT to comply with the requirements of this Notice, you may, under the provisions of sub-section (6) of the said section nineteen of the Drainage Act (Northern Ireland), 1947 (Reprint to 1952), appeal to the County Court on any ground specified in your said statement of objections provided that within fourteen days after the service of this Notice you give to the County Council a notice of your intention so to appeal setting forth the ground or grounds on which your appeal is brought.*

REGULATIONS, DATED 1ST JULY, 1952, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1947 TO 1951, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

1952. No. 106

The Ministry of Education in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 83 and 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1947, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and after consultation with the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Institutions of Further Education (Salaries and Allowances of Teachers) Amending Regulations, 1952.

2. The existing Regulations hereby amended are the Institutions of Further Education (Salaries and Allowances of Teachers) Regulations, 1951 (a).

3. The rates of salary prescribed in Regulations 5, 7, 8 and 12 of the existing Regulations shall be increased by £40 per annum in the case of men and by £32 per annum in the case of women in respect of service given on and after 1st July, 1952.

Grammar Schools (Admissions, Scholarships and Special Allowances) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1952.

REGULATIONS DATED 9TH JUNE, 1952, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1947 TO 1951.

1952. No. 93

The Ministry of Education in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Section 76 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1947, as amended by the Education (Extension of Benefits) Act (Northern Ireland), 1950, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations :—

- 1.—(a) These Regulations may be cited as the Grammar Schools (Admissions, Scholarships and Special Allowances) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1952.
- (b) These Regulations shall be construed as one with the Grammar Schools (Admissions, Scholarships and Special Allowances) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1950 (hereinafter referred to as “the Principal Regulations”) as amended by the Grammar Schools (Admissions, Scholarships and Special Allowances) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1951.
- (c) The Principal Regulations, the Grammar Schools (Admissions, Scholarships and Special Allowances) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1951, and these Regulations may be cited together as the Grammar Schools (Admissions, Scholarships and Special Allowances) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1950 to 1952.
