The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Importation) No. XI Order (Northern Ireland) 1952

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in it under the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894, as amended and adapted by any subsequent enactments and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, orders and it is hereby ordered as follows :-

1. Unless and until it is otherwise ordered by the Ministry, no potatoes or other vegetables shall be imported or brought into Northern Ireland from any country other than Great Britain, the Isle of Man, the Channel Islands or the Republic of Ireland except under a licence granted by the Ministry, and subject to such conditions as may be specified in the licence.

Offences

2. Any person committing or aiding, abetting, counselling or procuring the commission of any breach of the provisions of this Order is liable, on summary conviction, to the penalties provided by the Diseases of Animals Acts 1894-1948.

Interpretation

- 3. In this Order :-
 - "The Ministry" means the Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland.

Revocation

The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Importation) No. II Order (Northern Ireland) 1952, is hereby revoked.

Commencement

5. This Order shall come into operation on the date hereof.
