

**The Baking Wages Council (Northern Ireland) Wages Regulation  
(Amendment) (No. 1) Order, 1957**

Whereas the Ministry of Labour and National Insurance (hereinafter in this Order referred to as "the Ministry") has received from the Baking Wages Council (Northern Ireland) the wages regulation proposals set out in the Schedule hereto;

Now, therefore, the Ministry by virtue of the powers conferred on it by Section 10 of the Wages Councils Act (Northern Ireland), 1945(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. The wages regulation proposals set out in the Schedule hereto shall have effect on and from the specified date and as from the date immediately preceding the specified date the Baking Wages Council (Northern Ireland) Wages Regulation (Amendment) (No. 1) Order, 1956(b), shall cease to have effect.

2. In this Order the expression "the specified date" means the 25th day of July, 1957, provided that where, as respects any worker who is paid wages at intervals not exceeding seven days, that date does not correspond with the beginning of the period for which the wages are paid, the expression "the specified date" means, as respects that worker, the beginning of the next such period following that date.

3. This Order may be cited as the Baking Wages Council (Northern Ireland) Wages Regulation (Amendment) (No. 1) Order, 1957.

2.—the following paragraph were inserted after paragraph 3—

"WORKERS COMMENCING BETWEEN 5 A.M. AND 6 A.M.

Paragraph 3A.

*The general minimum time rates for male workers who commence work on a week day after 5 a.m. and before 6 a.m. shall be increased by 1s. 0d. in respect of each such day.*

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)*

This Order, which has effect on and from 25th July, 1957, amends the Baking Wages Council (Northern Ireland) Wages Regulation (No. 4) Order, 1955 (Order N.I.Bk. (205)) as amended by the Baking Wages Council (Northern Ireland) Wages Regulation (Amendment) (No. 1) Order, 1956 (Order N.I.Bk. (210)) by increasing the statutory minimum remuneration payable to Transport Workers, Stablemen and Harness Cleaners or Van Washers fixed by that Order. New provisions in the Schedule are printed in italics.

Order N.I.Bk. (210) is revoked.
