EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended, to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations prescribe that any teacher employed in a substitute or temporary capacity may be paid salary at a daily rate of 1/200th of the annual salary which he or she would receive if employed in a permanent capacity instead of, as formerly, at a daily rate of 1/200th of the minimum of the scales for the first 50 working days of the employment. They provide also for a post-ponement of the latest date by which teachers may elect to be paid in accordance with the salary scales and allowances and other conditions in force on 30th September, 1956, in preference to the scales, allowances and other conditions introduced in consequence of the recommendations of the ("Fox") Committee on the Salaries of Teachers (Cmd. 364, 365 and 366).

Postgraduate Studentships

REGULATIONS, DATED 7TH MAY, 1957, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1947 TO 1956, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

1957. No. 80 [C]

The Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry"), in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Section 77 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1947, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Postgraduate Studentships Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1957.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the 20th May, 1957.
- 2. After consultation with an Advisory Board composed of such suitably qualified persons as the Ministry may from time to time appoint thereto, the Ministry may make grants (hereinafter referred to as "postgraduate studentships") to students of approved qualifications.
 - 3. Postgraduate studentships may be:—
 - (a) Research Studentships, to assist students to undergo training in scientific research;
 - (b) Advanced Course Studentships, to assist students to pursue advanced courses of instruction in science and technology; or
 - (c) State Studentships, to assist students to undertake advanced study in Arts subjects.
- 4. Postgraduate Studentships shall be of such amount and be subject to such conditions as may be determined from time to time by the Ministry with the consent of the Ministry of Finance.

5.—(1) The Scientific Research Grants Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1950(a), are hereby revoked:

Provided that any award made under those Regulations may be continued as though it had been made under these Regulations.

(2) Notwithstanding the revocation of the Regulations referred to in the previous paragraph the holder of a Scientific Research Grant awarded thereunder may continue to hold the grant as if the Regulations had not been revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations make continued provision for the former Maintenance Allowances which will in future be known as Research Studentships, and, in addition, provide for the award of Advanced Course Studentships in Science and Technology and State Studentships in Arts subjects.

In future Senior Research Grants will be made by the Department of Scientific and Industrial Research, London.
