EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations provide that, where that part of a teacher's annual superannuation allowance which is in respect of non-participating employment falls to be reduced because the teacher's retirement has been accelerated by misconduct, the amount remaining after the reduction shall never be less than the maximum graduated National Insurance pension which would have been payable if the employment had been participating.

The Regulations also provide for the charging of expenditure in respect of payments in lieu to the Teachers Superannuation Account and make minor amendments consequent upon the power given to employers under Section 9 of the National Insurance Act (Northern Ireland), 1959, to recover half of a payment in lieu from a repayment of contributions.

Allocation of Annual Allowances

Rules, dated 30th December, 1960, made by the Ministry of Education under the Teachers (Superannuation) Acts (Northern Ireland), 1950 to 1956, with the approval of the Ministry of Finance.

The Ministry of Education in exercise of powers conferred on it by Section 14 of the Teachers (Superannuation) Act (Northern Ireland), 1950(a), as amended by Section 10 of the Teachers (Superannuation) (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland), 1956(b), and as applied by the Ministries (Transfer of Functions) (Teachers Superannuation) Order, 1951(c), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following rules:—

1. These rules may be cited as the Teachers (Superannuation) (Allocation) Amending Rules (Northern Ireland), 1960, and shall come into operation on the third day of April, 1961.

2. Rule 7 of the Teachers (Superannuation) (Allocation) Rules (Northern Ireland), 1957(d) (which relates to the amount of annual superannuation allowance which a teacher may surrender), is hereby amended by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph (b) thereof:—

"(bb) so much of his allowance as would make the part thereof (as reduced by the amount surrendered) which is in respect of contributory service after the second day of April, 1961, which was non-participating employment less than the graduated retirement

benefit which, when expressed as a yearly rate, would be payable to him under that Act in return for an amount of graduated contributions equal to one such contribution paid in each week of the period of such service in respect of a weekly payment of remuneration of fifteen pounds; provided that for the purposes of this paragraph the expression 'non-participating employment' and other expressions not otherwise defined in these rules have the same meanings as in the National Insurance Act (Northern Ireland), 1959(a); or".
