**Qualifications and Duties of Medical Officers**

REGULATIONS, DATED 24TH FEBRUARY, 1960, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNDER SECTIONS TEN AND TWENTY-EIGHT OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1946.

The Ministry of Health and Local Government in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections ten and twenty-eight of the Public Health and Local Government (Administrative Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland), 1946(a), hereby makes the following regulations, that is to say:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Authorities (Qualifications and Duties of Medical Officers) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1960.

2. In regulation 2 of the Health Authorities (Qualifications and Duties of Medical Officers) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1948(b), for paragraphs (2), (3) and (4) thereof there shall be substituted the following paragraph:—

“(2) he is a British subject.”

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)*

These Regulations remove from the qualifications required of persons for appointment as Medical Officer of Health, Deputy Medical Officer of Health or Assistant Medical Officer of a county or county borough, or Medical Officer of Health of a borough or urban or rural district or any combination thereof, the qualifications relating to health and character, residence and age and they revise the requirements relating to nationality.
