**CORONERS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1959**

ORDER, DATED 24TH MARCH, 1960, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION FORTY-ONE OF THE CORONERS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1959.

The Ministry of Home Affairs in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sub-section (2) of Section forty-one of the Coroners Act (Northern Ireland), 1959(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Coroners Act (Northern Ireland), 1959, (Date of Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland), 1960.

2. Sections one to forty of the Act shall come into operation on the 1st day of April, 1960.
