FERTILISERS AND FEEDING STUFFS

REGULATIONS, DATED 15TH DAY OF JANUARY, 1963, MADE BY THE MINISTRY
OF AGRICULTURE UNDER THE FERTILISERS AND FEEDING STUFFS ACT, 1926.

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 23 and 29 of the Fertilisers and Feeding Stuffs Act, 1926(a), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, and acting on the advice of the Advisory Committee appointed for Great Britain under Section 23 of the said Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Fertilisers and Feeding Stuffs (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1963. The Fertilisers and Feeding Stuffs Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1960(b) (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Regulations”) and these Regulations may be cited together as the Fertilisers and Feeding Stuffs Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1960 and 1963.

(2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the 15th day of January, 1963.

Amendment of Regulation 11 of the Principal Regulations

2. Regulation 11 of the principal Regulations shall be amended by inserting the words “or by the recorded delivery service” immediately after the words “registered post” wherever they appear in the said Regulation.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to
indicate their general purport.)*

The Fertilisers and Feeding Stuffs Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1960, require a part of a sample taken by an official sampler or by an inspector to be sent by registered post to the appropriate person specified in the Regulations. These amending Regulations make provision for such parts of samples to be sent by the recorded delivery service as an alternative to registered post.
