ROAD VEHICLES

Registration and Licensing

REGULATIONS, DATED 22ND MAY 1963, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 24 OF THE VEHICLES (EXCISE) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1954.

The Ministry of Home Affairs, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section twenty-four of the Vehicles (Excise) Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of June 1963, and may be cited as “The Road Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1963”.

(2) In these Regulations the expression “Principal Regulations” means the Road Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) (Northern Ireland) Regulations 1947(b).

2. The following sub-paragraph shall be substituted for sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph (ii) of Regulation 13 of the Principal Regulations:

“(c) the class and make of the vehicle;”.

3. In Regulation 27 of the Principal Regulations (which provides for making particulars of vehicles registered with a council available to certain persons and prescribes the fee payable for so doing) for the words “one shilling” there shall be substituted the words “five shillings”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations further amend the Road Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) (Northern Ireland) Regulations 1947 by (a) providing that the fee for making available to certain persons particulars of a vehicle registered with a council shall be five shillings instead of one shilling; and (b) dispensing with the requirement to enter the colour of a vehicle on its licence disc.
