MARKETING OF EGGS

RULES, DATED 23RD DAY OF DECEMBER, 1963, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 21 OF THE MARKETING OF EGGS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1957(a).

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 21 of the Marketing of Eggs Act (Northern Ireland) 1957 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Rules:—

Short Title and Commencement

1. These Rules may be cited as the Marketing of Eggs (Amendment No. 5) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1963, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1964.

Amendment to the Marketing of Eggs Rules

2. The Marketing of Eggs Rules (Northern Ireland) 1958(b) shall be amended as follows:

(1) For Paragraphs (2), (3) and (4) of Rule 21 the following paragraph shall be substituted:—

“(2) Every hen egg which is found on being tested to be:—

- (a) a first quality egg, or a soiled egg otherwise of first quality, and which is less than 1½ oz. in weight, or
- (b) a cracked egg otherwise of first quality, or
- (c) a second quality egg

shall be marked on the shell in a clear and indelible manner with such mark as the Board may from time to time prescribe.”

(2) Paragraph (5) of Rule 21 shall be re-numbered (3).

These Rules amend the Marketing of Eggs Rules (Northern Ireland) 1958 in respect of the marking of tested and graded eggs in the categories “extra small”, “cracks” and “seconds”.

HEALTH SERVICES**Dental Estimates Committee Fees**

REGULATIONS, DATED 24TH DECEMBER, 1963, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, UNDER THE HEALTH SERVICES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1948.

The Ministry of Health and Local Government, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 11(2)(e) and by paragraph 4(a) of Part IV of the First Schedule to the Health Services Act (Northern Ireland) 1948(a), and in conjunction with the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Services (Dental Estimates Committee Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1963, and shall come into operation on the 1st January, 1964.

2.—(1) The Board may pay the Chairman of the Northern Ireland Dental Estimates Committee (hereinafter called “the Committee”) the sum of 500 guineas per annum in respect of attendance at meetings of the Committee and for carrying out such other duties as may be assigned to him by the Board.

(2) The Board may pay to each member of the Committee other than the Chairman a fee of 8 guineas in respect of each attendance for a period of not less than two hours at a meeting of the Committee.

(3) Payment of the fees and remuneration provided for in these Regulations may not be made to any member of the Committee who is a member of either House of Parliament.

3. The Health Services (Dental Estimates Committee) (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1949(b) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)
