3. Any Exhibitions awarded under the revoked Regulations may be continued until their normal expiry dates as though those Regulations had not been revoked.

Teachers' Salariès (Compensation Allowances)

REGULATIONS, DATED 8TH MAY 1963, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1947 TO 1962.

The Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 83 and 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland) 1947(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf and after consultation with the Ministry of Finance hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Teachers' Salaries (Compensation Allowances) Amending Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1963.

(2) These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 26th February 1963.

2. The existing Regulations hereby amended are the Teachers' Salaries (Compensation Allowances) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1961(b).
