**DISEASES OF ANIMALS****Importation of Sheep from Scotland—Revocation**

ORDER, DATED 26TH MAY, 1964, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTIONS 13, 22, 23 AND 53 OF THE DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1958(a).

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 13, 22, 23 and 53 of the Diseases of Animals Act (Northern Ireland) 1958, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

*Citation and Commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Importation (Sheep from Scotland) (Revocation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1964 and shall come into operation on the 1st July, 1964.

*Revocation*

2. The Importation (Sheep from Scotland) Order (Northern Ireland) 1964(b) is hereby revoked.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)*

This Order revokes the Importation (Sheep from Scotland) Order (Northern Ireland) 1964, which allowed Scottish sheep to be imported into Northern Ireland under certain conditions without being subject to slaughter or to quarantine at the Ministry's Quarantine Station.
