**PROHIBITION OF SALE OR EXPORT OF HORNED CATTLE**

**Appointed Day**

ORDER, DATED 12TH JANUARY, 1966, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 20 OF THE AGRICULTURE (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1965.

Whereas it is provided by Section 20(1) of the Agriculture (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland) 1965(a) that any person who sells or offers or exposes for sale or sends out of Northern Ireland or who attempts to or permits or causes any other person to sell or offer or expose for sale or send out of Northern Ireland any horned cattle shall be guilty of an offence:

And whereas it is provided by Section 20(5) of the said Act that the said section shall come into operation on such day not being a day before the expiration of a period of three years from the passing of the said Act as the Minister of Agriculture may by Order appoint:

Now therefore I, the Right Honourable Henry William West, Minister of Agriculture, in exercise of the power conferred on me by Section 20(5) of the said Act, hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Horned Cattle (Appointed Day) Order (Northern Ireland) 1966.

2. Section 20 of the Agriculture (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland) 1965 shall come into operation on 1st February, 1969.
