EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order, which comes into operation on 22nd March, 1966, sets out the statutory minimum remuneration payable in substitution for that fixed by the Linen and Cotton Handkerchief and Household Goods and Linen Piece Goods Wages Regulation Order (Northern Ireland) 1965 (Order N.I.H.H.G. (177)) as amended by the Linen and Cotton Handkerchief and Household Goods and Linen Piece Goods Wages Regulation (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1966 (Order N.I.H.H.G. (180)).

Orders N.I.H.H.G. (177) and N.I.H.H.G. (180) are revoked. New provisions in the Schedule are printed in italics.

Grants to the Pigs Marketing Board

Scheme, dated 15th March, 1966, made by the Minister of Agriculture under Section 1 of the Agriculture (Temporary Assistance) Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(a), as amended by the Agriculture (Temporary Assistance) (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland) 1957(b).

The Minister of Agriculture with the approval of the Minister of Finance and in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by the Agriculture (Temporary Assistance) Acts (Northern Ireland) 1954 and 1957, and of all other powers him thereunto enabling, hereby makes the following Scheme:—

Short title and commencement

1.—(1) This Scheme may be cited as the Pigs Marketing (Improvement) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1966.

(2) This Scheme shall come into operation on the 15th March, 1966.

Interpretation

2. In this Scheme-

"Ministry" means the Ministry of Agriculture.

"Board" means the Pigs Marketing Board for Northern Ireland.

Purpose of grants

3. Subject to the provisions of this Scheme the Ministry may make to the Board grants towards expenditure which in the opinion of the Ministry has been reasonably incurred by the Board during the year ending 31st March, 1966, in the carrying out of measures designed to increase efficiency in the production, processing, handling, transporting, storage, presentation and marketing of Northern Ireland pigs and pig products and in maintaining the level of prices to farmers producing pigs, having regard to the costs of transporting pigs and pig products.

(2) The aggregate of grants made to the Board under this Scheme shall not exceed £250,000.
