The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 of the Climate Change (Scotland) Act 2009(a).

In accordance with section $96(4)(\mathbf{b})$ of that Act, a draft of this instrument has been laid before and approved by resolution of the Scottish Parliament.

Before the draft was so laid, the Scottish Ministers requested and had regard to the advice of the relevant $body(\mathbf{c})$ in accordance with section 5(1) and had regard to the matters in section 4(4) of that Act.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Climate Change (Annual Targets) (Scotland) Order 2011 and comes into force on the day after the day it is made.

Annual targets for the period 2023-2027

- **2.** The annual targets expressed in tonnes of carbon dioxide equivalent(**d**) for the period 2023-2027 are as follows—
 - (a) the annual target for 2023 is 37,161,000;
 - (b) the annual target for 2024 is 35,787,000;
 - (c) the annual target for 2025 is 34,117,000;
 - (d) the annual target for 2026 is 32,446,000;

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order implements the requirement imposed by section 4 of the Climate Change (Scotland) Act 2009 ("the 2009 Act") for the Scottish Ministers to make an order setting annual targets for the maximum amount of the net Scottish emissions account for each year in the period 2023-2027.

The Scottish Ministers requested advice from the relevant body (the UK Committee on Climate Change (UKCCC)) as required by section 5(1) of the 2009 Act. The UKCCC advice is set out in two letters dated 1st July 2011 and 1st August 2011, and available at http://www.scotland.gov.uk/Topics/Environment/climatechange/what-is/expertadvice/advisorybody.

Article 2 of the Order sets the annual target for each year for the period 2023-2027.
