CHAPTER 2

Schedule 1 activities

Schedule 1 conditions: volatile organic compounds

32.—(1) SEPA must ensure that a permit for a specified activity contains any condition SEPA considers necessary to ensure compliance with—

- (a) Directive [94/63/EC](#) of the European Parliament and Council on the control of volatile organic compound (VOC) emissions resulting from the storage of petrol and its distribution from terminals to service stations⁽¹⁾, and
- (b) Directive [2009/126/EC](#) of the European Parliament and the Council on stage II petrol vapour recovery during the refuelling of motor vehicles at service stations⁽²⁾.

(2) In this regulation, “specified activity” means an activity described in paragraphs (b) to (e) of Part B of Section 1.2 of Part 1 of Schedule 1.
